Summer Road Trip Car Prep Checklist

TIRES & WHEELS

- Inspect Tread Depth: Use the quarter test-insert a quarter into the tread with Washington's head down. If you can see the top of his head, it's time to replace the tire.
- □ Check Tire Pressure: Ensure all tires, including the spare, are inflated to the manufacturer's recommended PSI.
- □ **Look for Damage:** Examine tires for cuts, bulges or sidewall damage.
- □ **Rotate Tires:** Rotate tires every 5,000 to 7,500 miles to promote even wear.

BATTERY & ELECTRICAL

- Test Battery: Have your battery tested, especially if it's over three years old. AAA offers free testing for members.
- □ Clean Terminals: Ensure battery terminals are clean and free of corrosion.



□ Secure Connections: Check that battery cables are tightly connected.

ENGINE & FLUIDS

- Check Engine Oil: Verify oil level and condition; top off or change if necessary.
- Inspect Coolant Level: Ensure coolant is at the proper level to prevent overheating.
- □ **Brake Fluid:** Check brake fluid level and condition.
- □ **Transmission Fluid:** Verify transmission fluid is at the correct level and clean.



CLIMATE CONTROL

- □ **Test Air Conditioning:** Ensure the A/C is blowing cold air; have it serviced if not.
- □ **Replace Cabin Air Filter:** Change the cabin air filter to maintain air quality inside the vehicle.

EMERGENCY & SAFETY KIT

- First Aid Kit: Include bandages, antiseptics, pain relievers and any necessary medications.
- □ Jumper Cables: Carry a set of jumper cables or a portable jump starter.
- □ Flashlight & Batteries: Have a working flashlight with extra batteries.
- □ **Basic Tools:** Include screwdrivers, pliers and an adjustable wrench.
- Emergency Flares or Reflective Triangles: Use to alert other drivers if you're stopped on the roadside.
- □ Water & Snacks: Keep bottled water and non-perishable snacks on hand.

CLEANLINESS & COMFORT

- □ **Clean Interior & Exterior:** Wash and vacuum your car to start the trip fresh.
- Organize Essentials: Ensure registration, insurance and owner's manual are easily accessible.
- □ Entertainment: Download music, podcasts or audiobooks for the journey.
